

Most lockdown decisions focus on global lockdowns. However, events typically occur in hallways putting teachers and students in danger prior to administrative notification/response. Administrative lockdowns can also put students/teachers in greater harm by "orphaning" them in hallways. Therefore, an emergency response at the classroom door is critical.



Lockdown at the Door

- Safeguard students by allowing teachers to quickly lockdown the classroom door upon seeing/hearing an event
- Secure button or handle gesture on a Proxess lock puts the door into lockdown



Vicinity Lockdown

- Proxess allows Vicinity Lockdown when there is danger at the classroom door
- Proxess locksets are capable of being put into lockdown via BLE from a cell phone



Administrative (Global) Lockdown

Proxess BLE bridges allow for global lockdown from the software

- Proxess Lockdowns generate Automated Notifications to Administrators and First Responders

- Allows facilities to have flexibility when dangerous events occur
